

BRIAN CLIFFORD – Profile

Brian Clifford has lived in Sissinghurst for just about 40 years and this is his second period as a Parish Councillor.

Based on a career with senior executive editorial roles on national newspapers, including the Sunday Mirror, Sun and Daily Mail, Brian Clifford moved into television as a Yorkshire TV Producer and then onto the BBC, where he spent the next 25 years in a career that began as a television news scriptwriter and concluded as Head of Corporate Promotion for the BBC.

Brian Clifford's BBC career included senior management appointments as Head of Information Services (the BBC's television, radio and world service press and publicity department) and concluded having been responsible for the corporate image of the BBC winning several awards including a Gold Award from the Royal Television Society.

Brian Clifford then created Creative Corporate Communications – a strategic business development company together with a horse racing information web site he designed which was listed on the AIM Stock Exchange.

Most recently Brian Clifford has become Chairman of the Tunbridge Wells MS Society Group and is Editor of the Cranbrook and Sissinghurst Parish Council magazine PARISH CAKE

He is presently Chairman of the Parish Council Burials and Properties Committee and a member of the Environmental Committee.
